A. Normal heart B. Top view of valve open C. Pulmonic stenosis D. Top view of valve open E. Valve is narrowed and thickened and unable to open completely F. Harder to pump blood across narrowed obstructed valve G. Right ventricle becomes thickened H. Subvalvular- thickening of muscle below valve I. Valvular- narrow opening leaflets of valve are fused together and thickened J. Supravalvular-narrowing of pulmonary artery above valve
