




Spay Surgery in Cats




1. A small incision is made in the abdominal wall below the naval.




2. A cut is made through the suspensory ligament, freeing the ovary from the abdominal wall.




3. A spay hook is used to isolate the uterine horn and the ovarian pedicle is ligated.



4. The process is repeated on the opposite side and the uterine body is tied off.



5. The uterine body is cut away, leaving behind a small amount of uterine tissue.



6. Once the uterus and ovaries are removed, the incision is closed with sutures.
